Each of the UMTYMP courses has a site on the University's Moodle server. Moodle provides a website where you can download copies of the class schedule or syllabus, view a summary of your grades, and a forum where you can post questions and get help from other students, teaching assistants, and instructors. To log into your Moodle site, follow these directions.

- (1) Go to the MathCEP homepage, <http://www.mathcep.umn.edu>. In the "Quick Links" section on the upper right, click on the link to the Moodle site for your course.
  
- (2) When prompted, log in with your username and account.
  - (a) For students in Algebra: your username is your "guest ID."

This guest ID will be sent during (or before) the first week of class to the student's email address, which you provided on your registration form. You must type the guest ID and password exactly as you received them via email, including all digits and matching the capital and lowercase letters.
  
  - (b) For students in Geometry: if you provided us with a new student email address on your registration form, you will be sent an email with a new guest ID during the first week of class. You should follow the directions above for the Algebra students to login with this new guest ID. All other Geometry students should use the same ID and password as last year; if you have forgotten your guest ID, the UMTYMP office can provide it for you. We cannot reset your password, however—see the box below.
  
  - (c) For students in Calculus I-III: your username is your University x500 id. If you have never used your x500 account, follow the **Internet Account** link under **Need an Account?** Then click the button to initiate your student account and follow the ensuing directions. The activation form will ask for your Social Security Number, but you should leave that field empty. Your student ID number is on the enrollment sheet which will be handed out in class. If you have used your x500 account before but have forgotten your user name, you can find it by searching for yourself at <http://search.umn.edu>.

**Please Note:** Although we can remind students of their usernames, we have no control over their passwords or the login system; it is run by a central University office. Call the help-line phone number on the login screen, (612) 301-4357, if you need assistance.

- (3) Once you have successfully logged into the Moodle site, you can click on links to download the syllabus or use the forums. The link to the electronic gradebook is in the column on the left. (Grades are usually uploaded for the first time at the end of the second week of class.)
  
- (4) Go to <http://www.umn.edu/myaccount> at any time to update your account password or configure other options.
