

Each of the 2010-11 UMTYMP courses now has a site on the University's Moodle server. Moodle provides a website where you can download copies of the class schedule or syllabus, view a summary of your grades, and a forum where you can post questions and get help from other students, teaching assistants, and instructors. To log into your Moodle site, follow these directions.

- (1) Go to the MathCEP homepage, <http://www.mathcep.umn.edu>. In the "Quick Links" section on the upper right, click on the link to the Moodle site for your course. Alternatively, if you are reading this document in a PDF viewer which allows you to click on links, you can choose your course here: [Algebra](#), [Geometry/Math Analysis](#), [Calculus I](#), [Calculus II](#), [Calculus III](#).
- (2) When prompted, log in with your username and account.
  - (a) For students in the high school component: your username is your "guest ID" and has the form `bgxxNNNN`, where `NNNN` represents a four digit number. You must type the guest ID and password exactly as you received them via email, including all digits and matching the capital and lowercase letters.
  - (b) For students in Calculus I-III: your username is your University `x500` id, which you can get from your instructor or by calling the office. If you have never used your `x500` account, follow the directions on the login screen to activate it. The activation form will ask for your Social Security Number, but you should leave that field empty.

**Please Note:** Although we can remind students of their usernames, we have no control over their passwords or the login system; it is run by a central University office. Call the help-line phone number on the login screen if you need assistance.

- (c) Once you have successfully logged into the Moodle site, you can click on links to download the syllabus or use the forums. The link to the electronic gradebook is in the column on the left. (Grades summaries will likely be uploaded for the first time on Friday, 10/29/2010.)
- (3) Go to <http://www.umn.edu/myaccount> at any time to update your University account password or configure other options.
