

Each of the UMTYMP courses has a site on the University's Moodle server. Moodle provides a website where you can download copies of the class schedule or syllabus, view a summary of your grades, and a forum where you can post questions and get help from other students, teaching assistants, and instructors. To log into your Moodle site, follow these directions.

- (1) Go to the MathCEP webpage, <http://www.mathcep.umn.edu>, and use the menus to find the page for Current UMTYMP students. Alternatively, navigate directly to:

<http://www.mathcep.umn.edu/umtymp/information-current-students>.

In the "Quick Links" section on the upper right, click on the link to the Moodle site for your course.

- (2) When prompted, log in with your username and account.
  - (a) For students in Algebra or Geometry: use the same account and password as you used for the registration system when you enrolled in the class. You might have to ask your parents (or whichever adult completed your registration) for this information.
  - (b) For students in Calculus I-III: your username is your University x500 id. If you have never used your x500 account, follow the **Internet Account** link under **Get an Account**. Then click the button to initiate your student account and follow the ensuing directions. The activation form will ask for your Social Security Number, but you should leave that field empty. Your student ID number is on the enrollment sheet which will be handed out in class. If you have used your x500 account before but have forgotten your user name, you can find it by searching for yourself at <http://search.umn.edu>.

**Please Note:** Although we can remind students of their usernames, we have no control over their passwords or the login system; it is run by a central University office. Call the help-line phone number on the login screen, (612) 301-4357, if you need assistance. If the help-line cannot solve your issue, please contact the MathCEP office.

- (3) Once you have successfully logged into the Moodle site, you can click on links to download the syllabus or use the forums. The link to the electronic gradebook is in the column on the left. (Grades are usually uploaded for the first time at the end of the second week of class.)
- (4) Go to <https://it.umn.edu/technology/my-account> at any time to update your account password or configure other options. In particular, we recommend families of Calculus I-III students follow the directions at

which explain how to log in to <https://www.myu.umn.edu> and suppress directory information, so that students' home addresses and phone numbers are not publicly available. (Because the University is a public institution, this information is public by default for anybody who is earning credits in University courses, including our UMTYMP Calculus students.)
